Severe Conditions	50% Screenwash	50% Water	1:1	-25°C
Extreme Winter	100% Screenwash	-	1:0	-65°C

Increasing the screenwash concentration in extremely dirty conditions will improve the cleaning performance.

To use as a De-icer: spray the undiluted product via a trigger spray onto the windscreen.
